Dear Chairman Kilgore,

Since the 2015 announcement of the proposed merger between Wellmont Health Systems and Mountain States Health Alliance I have followed the process with interest in local media.

Being a member of the Baby Boomer generation I have personally witnessed many changes in how health care is excessed and administered. I've viewed and experienced its effectiveness or lack thereof and how the costs associated have spiraled higher and higher. Having a career that spans both the private and public sector I know the struggles of business owners as well as government agencies who help fund their employee's health care.

As you are aware I've been honored to serve as Mayor of the Town of Haysi now for over eight years. Being able to offer health care to our full time employees is something our town has always put at a high priority. While we only employee three full time staff members I've saw in those eight years co-workers face life threatening diseases, disabling chronic health conditions and many other health related issues.
